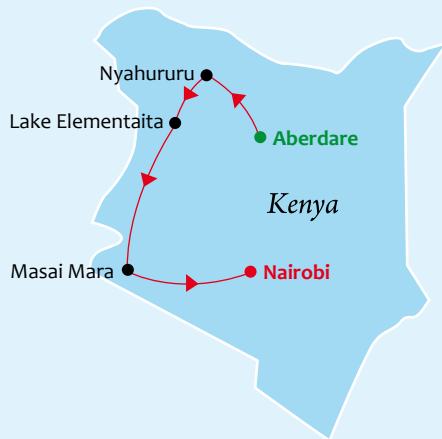

## Day 1 Aberdare

Jambo! Welcome to Kenya. On arrival at the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in Nairobi, you will be picked up and drive to Aberdare in our safari van (one group transfer). Overnight in Aberdare. (D)

## Day 2 Nyahururu

This morning you are driven to the Solio Ranch, a privately-owned wildlife conservancy, geared toward rhino conservation. Here there is a good chance of your spotting these huge animals.



Later you proceed towards Nyahururu to view the Thompson Falls, a scenic 74 m (243 ft) waterfall on the Ewaso Ng'iro river, named after fur trapper David Thompson. Upstream from the falls is one of the highest hippo pools in Kenya. Overnight in Nyahururu. (B, L, D)

### Day 3 Lake Elementaita

Early this morning you will be driven to Lake Elementaita, a shallow soda lake in the Great Rift Valley, which is home to pelicans, storks and flamingos. Overnight in Lake Elementaita. (B, L, D)

### Day 4 Masai Mara

Today you are driven to the Masai Mara National Reserve, a large game reserve in Narok County, Kenya. Further on you will see people of the Masai tribes, almost completely unaffected by modern civilization. During an afternoon game drive inside Masai Mara National Reserve you have good chances of seeing some of the wildlife that this Reserve is famous for - lions, elephants, cheetahs and leopards, as well as gazelles, antelopes and a variety of birds. Overnight in Masai Mara. (B, L, D)

### Day 5 Masai Mara

Today you are taken for an extensive game drive into the Masai Mara National Reserve, to see crocodiles and hippos resting in the water. In the afternoon, you will be drive even deeper into the reserve to see herds of wild beasts - elephants, buffaloes, zebras, rhinos, leopards and perhaps even a pride of lions. Overnight in Masai Mara. (B, L, D)



### Day 6 Nairobi

You depart for Nairobi, the capital and largest city of Kenya, in our safari van. Enroute there is a stop at the edge of the Great Rift Valley for a magnificent view of the valley and the two volcanoes. On arrival you are taken to the Giraffe Centre where you get an opportunity to get up and close and personal with the giraffes, as well as get a chance to feed them. Later you are taken on a short orientation tour of the city. Overnight in Nairobi. (B, L, D)

### Day 7 Return Home

Today, After breakfast, your 'Kenya Safari' tour ends as you check out of the hotel. It's time to say goodbye to all the new friends you have made. ## Handy Tips - Africa

### ON ARRIVAL INTO AFRICA



- All joining direct passengers will have to reach the respective hotel/airport, on their own and check in.

### BAGGAGE REGULATIONS AND SOME RECOMMENDATIONS



- Airlines allow maximum of 23 kgs per person as check-in baggage. One small handbag is allowed per person as cabin baggage, which should not weight more than 5 kgs. Different airlines will have different baggage policies.
- We suggest that you carry one set of clothes along with your daily utility items and other accessories in your hand baggage. This is just a precautionary measure in case your baggage is misplaced.
- We advice that you travel as light as possible, since Porterage is not included in your tour price and carrying heavy luggage would be inconvenient. Prefer bags with wheels and sturdy handles, as they are more convenient.
- Please note that airlines do not permit items like loose batteries, razor blades, nail cutter, scissors, knives, gels, any form of liquid, cigarette lighter in your hand baggage. If required carry such items in your check-in bag.
- Please ensure that you do not place any valuables in your check-in bag. Carry your foreign currency / travel documents / jewelry / insurance in your hand bag.

### MEALS



- You have a choice of Veg / Jain / non-veg meals. The menus, are fixed in advance and a la carte is not possible.
- A combination of Indian and local meals is not possible. Most dinner are unlimited buffets, but it is requested that you do not waste food.

### TOUR MANAGER / LOCAL GUIDES



- The SOTC Tour Manager is your guide and friend on tour. To compliment the services of our highly trained Tour Managers, we employ an expert local guide to go through the sightseeing attractions in specific cities. Please note that the services of SOTC Tour Manager on the tour is subject to minimum participation of 15 passengers (unless specified). We request you to kindly cooperate with them and abide with his/her instructions for a memorable tour.

### HOTELS & ROOMS



- Your hotels have been specially chosen, keeping in mind the location and space availability.
- Early check-in and late check-out will not be permitted by the hotel.
- Most hotels offer the facility of complimentary safe deposit lockers (few hotels charge a refundable deposit). We advice that you keep all your valuables like money, passport, tickets and jewelry in the locker, in case you are staying for more than one day at the hotel.
- Please make sure that no damages are done to your hotel room during the stay, as the same would be charged to you directly by the hotel.
- Hotel rooms may have facilities like mini-bar, pay television channels, telephones etc. Please note that these facilities are not complimentary and will be charged as per actual usage.
- Please note that we will try our best to provide you with adjacent rooms that have been asked by you at the time of booking, but the same will be subject to availability at the time of check-in. It is also difficult to provide interconnecting rooms, however the tour manager and the hotel will try their best to ensure that you are provided with adjacent rooms wherever possible.

### VACCINATION



- If you are traveling to Kenya, it is mandatory to get yourself vaccinated against Yellow Fever & oral polio vaccinations, 10 days prior to arrival into Kenya and carry the original certificates of the vaccinations along with you on your tour.

### CLOTHING



#### Kenya:

It is recommended that you carry long sleeves shirts & trousers as it will help protect you against sun & mosquitoes. As you will be going on safari, pack comfortable walking shoes along with khaki, beige & brown casual clothes. Also carry warm jacket for game drives. A light rain coat is advisable to carry.

#### South Africa:

Lightweight clothing is advisable although evenings can be cool. Sun screen, hats and sunglasses are a must and remember that sunburn can occur even in overcast weather.

### TIPPING POLICY



- Mandatory tips of USD 3 per person per day for Coach drivers, Guides etc.

### TIME MANAGEMENT



- Its very important to be on time and punctual on your tour, since your itinerary has been designed and planned to offer you the most on your holiday. Every sightseeing trip where you get off has an allotted time, please make sure you remain with the group and return at the allotted time. Any delay would actually deprive the entire group of their sightseeing time.

### ESSENTIAL ITEMS TO BE CARRIED



- Your passport, air tickets, original insurance policy, final Invoice, Tour Confirmation Voucher and necessary foreign exchange for personal use.
- Also carry a photocopy of your passport including valid visas and keep them separately from the original.
- Please do not forget to carry an additional pair of spectacles if you are using one, digital camera chips with higher MB, extra batteries, chargers for digital camera and mobile.
- Carry mobile phone charger if you are carrying your cell phone with global roaming. You should carry multi-purpose adapter as sockets are different in different countries.
- Required medicines, with doctor's prescription.
- Most hotels do not provide hot water kettle and the same needs to be carried with you along with tea bags, sugar etc. in case you wish to make tea/coffee in the room. Please ensure that no damage occur to the hotel property.

### COACH



- It is very important to maintain a pleasant environment on coach and keep the coach neat and clean. Please do not eat foodstuff in the coach/van. We regret that, in the interest of fellow customers, smoking and drinking alcoholic beverages is not permitted on the coach/van.
